Towards an environmentally sustainable Cuddington

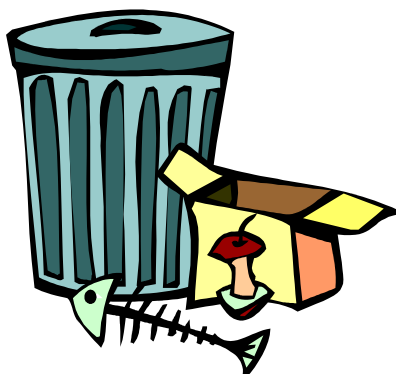
## Cuddington residents care for their local environment
